

My Learning Journey: Maths

<u>Objective:</u>	<u>Self-Assessment</u>
I can...	
Tell the time to o'clock, half past, quarter to & quarter past	
Tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes (for some children)	
Estimate and measure length (cm/m), mass (g/kg), capacity (litres/ml) and temperature (°C)	
Select and use appropriate equipment for measuring e.g. rulers, scales, vessels and thermometers	
Compare and order length, mass, capacity & temperature and record the results using >, < and = (greater than, less than and equal to).

<u>Objective:</u>	<u>Self-Assessment</u>
I can...	
Read a range of texts, make predictions about what might happen next and answer 'why' questions	
Use an apostrophe to mark where letters are missing and to show possession e.g. it's a rainy day, the girl's name	
Use full stops and capital letters correctly	
Use conjunctions e.g. and , or , but & so to join sentences and because , when , if & that to add detail	
Use expanded noun phrases to describe and specify e.g. the blue butterfly, plain flour	
Research and write explanatory non-fiction about insects/pond creatures	
Use a contents page, index and glossary of a non-fiction book	
Improve and edit my own writing.	
	



General Information

- Topic: Our topic this term is called 'Minibeasts'. We will be learning about the habitats of our local environment, making observations about the creatures we find and writing our own non-fiction books.
- Trips: We are planning two trips this term. Mrs Cataldo will be taking the children to Stockway North nature reserve on Monday 10th June for a morning of bug hunting and pond dipping. The children will then finish the term with a trip to Bristol Zoo on Thursday 11th July with Mrs Field where they will participate in a habitats workshop. Please keep an eye out for letters for both of these trips. Parent helpers will be needed so please see the relevant teacher to volunteer your time.
- Year 2 Summer Sing: the children will take part in a singing festival for local schools this term. They will be learning lots of songs from around the world - expect to hear them at home! We will try to arrange a mini performance for families near the end of term.

Homework

Task 1: To celebrate our topic this term, we would love our classroom to be the home to lots of insects and pond creatures. We invite (or challenge) you to create a large 3D model of a 'minibeast' to display in class. In the spirit of the children's passion for the environment, they might choose to use recycled materials to create their models. Be as creative as you like!

Time: Using an **analogue** clock or watch, talk about daily routines and times of the day e.g. 'We need to be ready in 15 minutes. Can you tell me when we need to leave?', 'Can you tell me when it's time for bed at quarter past 7?', 'How many quarters of an hour between getting up at half past 7 and school at quarter to 9?'
