

My Learning Journey: Maths

<u>Objective:</u>	<u>Self-Assessment</u>
I can...	
Read Roman Numerals from 1 to 100 (I to C).	
Count in multiples of 25 and 1,000.	
Order and compare numbers beyond 1,000.	
Recognise the place value of each digit in a four-digit number (e.g. 1234 is 1000+200+30+4).	
Find 1,000 more or less than a number.	
Round any number to the nearest 10, 100 or 1,000.	
Count backwards through 0 to include negative numbers (3, 2, 1, 0, -1, -2, -3).	
Use the column method to add and subtract up to four digit numbers.	
Check my answers using estimation or the inverse operation (I know $3+4=7$ so $7-3=4$).	
Solve two-step addition and subtraction questions.	
Recall multiplication and division facts up to the 8 times table.

Write riddles to read aloud and perform, using the intonation, tone and volume in my voice for effect.	
Draw inferences from what I have read such as what a character thinks and feels based on their actions.	
Distinguish between some homophones and choose the correct spelling for the meaning I want.	
Write a descriptive recount.	
Write instructions.
