**My Learning Journey: Maths**

<b><u>Objective:</u></b>	<b><u>Self-Assessment</u></b>
I can...	
Recall and use multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12 x 12	
Count in multiples of 6, 7, 9, 25 and 1,000	
Multiply by 0 and 1 and divide by 1	
Multiply together three numbers	
Solve problems involving multiplying and adding, including using the distributive law to multiply 2-digit numbers by one digit (I know $6 \times 30 = 180$ because $6 \times 3 \times 10 = 180$ )	
Measure and calculate the perimeter of a rectilinear figure (a shape with straight sides meeting at right angles), including squares, in centimetres and metres	
Convert between different units of measure (e.g. kilometre to metre).
