Our History Topic this term is Ancient Greece. Year 6 will use maps to establish the location of Greece within the world and also identify some major cities and landmarks. The children will learn about everyday life in ancient Greece and will find out about different life styles. They will discover the role that the Gods and Goddesses played for Greek citizens. During the term they will be asked to bring in the ingredients to make a Greek salad. More details to follow.
