Year 6 Mobile Phone Agreement

We permit year 6 pupils to bring mobile phones to school only if the child is walking to and from the school unsupervised by an adult or in other exceptional circumstances pre-arranged with the school.

The school will endeavour to keep phones safe and secure but children bring phones to school at their own risk.

Guidelines

- Mobile phones should only be brought to school by pupils with permission from a parent/carer
- Mobile phones should be switched off upon arrival at school and only switched on again after 3.15pm
- After 3.15pm, mobile phones should be used for essential purposes only eg to contact parents or carers
- Mobile phones should be stored in a teacher's cupboard throughout the day (not in a school bag)
- There will be no access to mobile phones during the school day for any reason; all messages should be sent and received via the school office only
- The use of mobile phones, and this agreement, will fit within the ICT e-safety and acceptable use policies.

If any of the above guidelines are breached, a warning will be issued; if there are further breaches, this could result in a mobile phone being confiscated and the pupil banned from bringing a mobile phone to school.
