PRIMARY PE AND SPORT FUNDING 2014-15

St Francis received £8,839 for the academic year 2014-15.

This government funding is ring fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools.

At St Francis we aim to:

- broaden the range of activities we provide children and give them new experiences through curricular opportunities and after school clubs
- provide opportunities for competitive school sport
- develop a legacy where all teachers are confident and competent in teaching high quality PE lessons

We will be using some of the sports funding to continue to participate in 'The Legacy Project', with Future Stars and Bristol Rugby Community Foundation.

Teachers and pupils will be working with two qualified specialist sports coaches for some of their PE lessons throughout the academic year. This allows the teacher to observe the children more closely and work with groups of children.

Working with Future Stars enables us to offer children a variety of lunchtime and after school clubs. Children are also offered the opportunity to participate in some professional match day experiences.

PE and Sport Activity September 2014-March 2015
Buying into the N Somerset PE Association which includes CPD opportunities for staff and curriculum support / enrichment for children.
The employment of specialist sports coaches to work alongside teachers in lessons – The Legacy Project, Future Stars.
Continuing the provision of lunchtime clubs.
Supporting transport costs/ticket price to Team Bath Netball event (Y5/6).
Transport to local sports events.
The employment of a specialist dance teacher.
The purchase of a dance scheme of work for all year groups.
Jazz and swing dance workshop for years 1-6 - Bristol Jazz and Blue festival

The purchase of new sports equipment for use in PE lessons.

Providing time for the PE subject leader attend training and lead this initiative.
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PE and Sport Activity April 2015- August 2015
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Continuing to use specialist coaches to provide curriculum support for all classes, including athletics.
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Play leaders training for year 5 pupils (PE association membership)

Continuing the provision of lunchtime clubs to include an athletics club for Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 pupils.
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Attend North Somerset Level 2 competition events, including transport costs.
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In school competition for all classes during the summer term, including a tag rugby tournament.

Future Stars coaching has taught me how to initially assess confidence and skill, differentiate effectively and how to challenge the more able within a skill set. I have learnt some more warm up games and how to engage the less confident members of a class.

The athletics sessions were well organised with a good variety of activities. There were lots of useful tips on how to improve performance, stamina and techniques.
