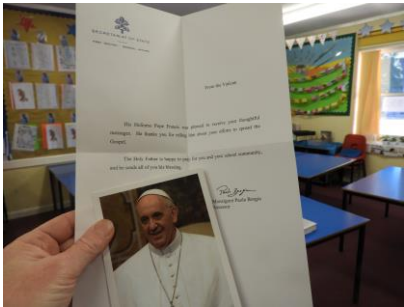


Newsletter ~ Term 6, Week 1
