Year 2 Indian Food Workshop

As part of the topic work we are doing in Geography this term, I am planning to take the children to Tesco's in Nailsea on Wednesday 10 October 2018. The children will be taken around the shop floor, finding out where food originates from and searching for different types of Indian food. I am asking for a parental contribution of £1.00 for this trip so that we can purchase some curries, rice, poppadoms, naan bread, Indian spices and chutneys for the children to sample on their return to school.
