## Year 2 Trips/Activities – Term 6 2018

### NAILSEA MUSIC FESTIVAL Tuesday 19 June

On the morning of Tuesday 19 June we will be taking part in the Nailsea Music Festival. It will take place at Golden Valley School, and children from local schools will be meeting together to sing songs based on the theme of keeping fit. We will be walking to Golden Valley so please ensure your child brings a coat in case of rain. He/she may wear clothes with a sporty theme for this event (e.g. football kit, leotards, shorts/T-shirt). We will be back at St Francis' by lunch time, so normal dinner arrangements will apply. There is no charge for this trip.

### NAILSEA NATURE RESERVE Wednesday 4 July

As part of the work we will be doing in Science, we will be visiting the nature reserve in Nailsea on the morning of **Wednesday 4 July**. The children will follow a programme led by volunteers who work at the reserve. There will be a discussion about living things followed by a workshop of National Curriculum based activities including pond dipping, plant identification and a mini beast hunt. The children will walk to and from the reserve, stopping for a playtime at the park by Tesco's on the way back to school. Once again, a coat will be required. There is no charge for this trip and normal school dinner arrangements will apply.

### SLIMBRIDGE WETLANDS CENTRE Friday 6 July

Slimbridge is a Wetlands Centre in Gloucestershire where the children will learn about water birds. At Slimbridge the children will follow a special programme led by the Wetlands staff and there will be lots of hands on activities and learning opportunities. Some of the activities will take place in the education centre and others outside. The children do not need to wear school uniform but will need a waterproof coat and strong outdoor shoes. They will also require a packed lunch and a drink (in a plastic, leak proof container). Your child will take his/her PE kit with him/her as there will be time to play in Welly boot Land and may get a little wet!

The cost of the visit will be £12.00. This will cover the entry fee and activities at Slimbridge, plus coach travel. Please pay for this trip through your ParentPay account by **Friday 15 June**. On ParentPay, when you go to "Add to basket" please type an emergency contact number for the day – no other information, just the contact number! If there are any problems with ParentPay, please contact the school office.
