Year 3 School Trip to Stoke Leigh Woods Iron Age Fort, Leigh Woods Thursday 18 October

I would like to take the children on a class trip to Leigh Woods. The children will be taking part in a number of workshops led by the National Trust education team (who are based at Tyntesfield House) which will support next term's study of the Iron Age.

We will travel by coach, leaving school at 9.15 am and returning in time for normal dismissal at 3.15 pm.

The children will need to wear suitable outdoor clothes for these activities, including a waterproof coat and wellington boots or strong shoes. Your child will require a packed lunch and two drinks; being outside all day is hungry and thirsty work! As we will be taking part in a workshop which involves wheat, please contact me if your child has a gluten allergy.

This trip is being subsidised by the annual class grant from the Friends, with a parental contribution of **£11.50** per child.
