E-safety for Families

We have the opportunity to run a series of free e-safety sessions in the New Year, which will be offered in the first instance to parents of year 5 and 6 children.

The sessions will be run by a tutor from the North Somerset Community Learning team and it aims to give parents and children a better understanding of the risks that exist when using the internet. It will also offer a safe forum in which parents and children can talk about their use of the internet and how families can establish protocols to help children keep safe.

We will ask you to bring a hand held device to school during these sessions which has the capacity to connect to the internet using 3G or 4G.

We need at least 8 parents to sign up to these sessions in order for the family learning team to start planning and we can offer up to a maximum of 12 places. Please return the pro forma to school as soon as possible and **by Friday 12 January** to ensure that you secure one of these places.

The sessions will run on the dates below **between the hours of 2.15 and 4pm**. Children will join their parents after the end of the school day for the last $\frac{3}{4}$ hour.
