CLASS TRIP – Friday 7 December to Caerleon Roman Museum

Dear Parents/Carers

I am planning a trip to Caerleon Roman Fortress on **Friday 7 December** to support our project learning about the Romans. During our visit, the children will have the opportunity to visit a museum containing Roman artefacts, go on a tour round the Roman baths, visit the ruins of a Roman barracks and walk around an amphitheatre. The children will also attend a workshop where they will get the chance to dress up as a Roman gladiator and experience life in the barracks.

In view of the distance, we must leave school at **9.00 am promptly** and will return by the end of the day for normal dismissal at 3.15 pm. School uniform and school shoes should be worn unless it is wet underfoot, in which case wellies or walking boots would be preferable. A jacket/waterproof is essential as we will be outdoors for much of the day. The children will need a fruit snack, packed lunch and drink (a water bottle rather than a carton).

This trip is being subsidised by the annual class grant from the Friends, with a parental contribution of **£10.00** per child. Please make payment through your ParentPay account by **Monday 26 November**. As you go to "Add to Basket", please type in **only** your preferred emergency contact number for the day. Do not add any other details.
